Practice profile

After a successful completion of his pupillage with Mr Valentine Yim, Mr Paul Leung, Mr Alan Ng, Mr Eugene Yim and Ms Amanda Li, Eddie joined our Chambers in 2016 and commenced his practice.

Eddie has a broad practice which covers all aspects of civil matters, including commercial litigation, bankruptcy and corporate insolvency matters, matrimonial disputes and personal injury claims (both PI & EC claims). He has appeared before the District Court and the Court of Instance, both as sole counsel and as a junior counsel.

Eddie is developing a broad criminal practice and has experience in handling cases involving offences such as sexual offences, criminal intimidation, theft, conspiracy to defraud, possession/ trafficking in dangerous drugs breach of conditions of stay and assault.

Eddie is currently acting for nine of the applicants (led by Mr Abraham Chan S.C. and Ms Maggie Wong SC) as junior counsel in *HKSAR v Li YP & Ors* (CACC 425/2015), an unprecedented case prosecuting "tou ding" (套丁).

Eddie has experience in conducting various types of disciplinary board proceedings and administrative appeal board hearings, including the Medical Council of Hong Kong, Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong, Registered Fire Service Installation Contractors Disciplinary Board and Administrative Appeals Board.
